About Kilbryde Hospice

Our services include...

Care @ Home Project

Kilbryde Hospice in partnership with Haven and St Andrew's Hospice offer hospice care at home with regular contact by specialist nurses to address the emotional and psychological needs of patients and carers. This service is for patients who cannot access the hospice due to ill health. This service is in conjunction with the GPs and other health and social care services.

What is Hospice Care?

*A hospice is not just a building.
It is a way of caring for people.*

Hospice care aims to improve the lives of people who have a progressive life limiting illness.

We aim to deliver care to people who have a deteriorating condition and preserve their quality of life. The highest value is put on respect, dignity and choice.

We not only take care of physical needs, we consider emotional, spiritual and social needs, and we also support family, carers and close friends, both during the illness and bereavement.

Day Services

Patients attending Day Services will be assessed weekly and care will be planned in conjunction with their GP and extended nursing team. Referral to this service is via the patients GP, specialist nurse or hospital consultant. Care will be given over varying lengths of time depending on each patient's needs.

Drop In

Drop-in services aims to support any patients with life limiting illness, their carers and family members to manage symptoms, improve confidence and improve quality of life. What we can offer is a supportive environment, care and companionship, recognising and addressing patient's needs, information giving and bereavement support.

Our staff and volunteers are on hand in the Drop In area to welcome you Monday to Friday 10am-4pm. Just Drop In – no need to book.

Therapeutic Care

Our wide range of therapies include complementary therapies such as Reflexology, Aromatherapy and Massage together with Creative Therapies in particular Music therapy and counselling.

In-patient Care

Kilbryde Hospice has a 12 bed in-patient unit where we will provide care to our patients with life limiting illnesses. As part of our phased approach, we plan to have this service running by summer 2016.



Get Involved

Kilbryde Hospice services are free to the individuals, their families and carers who need our support.

We currently receive some NHS funding, but mainly rely on the generous support of the local public who help us bring in the funds required to keep our vital services running.

It cost over £4 million to build Kilbryde Hospice and every penny was raised by local individuals, schools, groups and companies. When fully operational the hospice will cost around £2.5 million per year to run.

Whether you are a sole fundraiser, a community group, a school or a company, there are so many ways that you can support Kilbryde Hospice and help our patients receive the best possible hospice care when they need it most.
