Díd you know?

Kilbryde Hospice:

- We have had 140 admissions to our in-patient unit.
- We cared for 553 day services patients.
- Our CLAN team went on 111 home visits.
- We provided 292 music therapy or counselling sessions for patients & families.
- Our befrienders visited 240 patients.
- Fully operational the Hospice costs around £2.6 million per year to run.
- Our volunteers donated 34,281 hours of their time -based on the living wage this would have cost us £347,103.
