Spiritual Care at Kilbryde Hospice

Our Chaplain and a team of SC volunteers are here to help and support patients, families, carers, staff and volunteers in any way we can. We offer support to all faiths and none. SC support is not all about religion or spirituality, so it does not need to be a religious discussion you may want to have.

- Do you need a listening ear without prejudice or judgement?
- Do you need emotional support?
- Do you need somewhere to seek spiritual support?

Then our SC Team are here to help and provide this for you.

We have at this time, one member of staff and a team of SC volunteers. We are based at the Hospice and can be contacted through our reception or care staff.

If you would like to arrange to have some time with a chaplain or a SC volunteer for a chat please ask at reception or one of the nurses, and they can arrange this for you.

It is normal for us to walk around the building having a chat with anyone in Day Services, Drop In, or Kilbryde Kafe but appointments can be made to suit your current arrangements with hospice staff.

The SC Team is here:

- To provide emotional care and support.
- To ensure that your spiritual care and emotional needs are met whilst at the Hospice.
- To offer spiritual support to all.
- To have a meaningful input to the holistic care of patients.
- To act as a link between community based belief groups.
- To provide regular drop in groups and non-denominational services (Wednesday 11.15 a.m. and Thursday 1.15 p.m.) in the Sanctuary.
- To provide resources you need to allow you to practice your own faith whilst you are here.
- To liaise with your particular faith representative on your behalf at your request.
- To arrange, at your request, Holy Communion or relevant sacraments.
- To provide ongoing support and bereavement services.
- To be available to your family and carers should they need it.
- To provide non-biased, non-judgemental support.
